**ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING PROFESSIONAL FIDUCIARY SUBMISSION OF  
CRIMINAL BACKGROUND REPORT AND CREDIT HISTORY PURSUANT  
TO CRS § 15-14-110 (2)(a) AND ESTABLISHING ANNUAL REVIEW**

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on its own motion. Commencing on July 1, 2005 the Colorado Legislature requires that the Court obtain a criminal background report and a credit history about each nominee to be named guardian or conservator.

Some of the applicants are professional fiduciaries who appear in multiple cases. Because it is cumbersome on both the applicant and on the Court to obtain and file multiple criminal background reports and credit reports, the Court FINDS that it is appropriate to allow certain professional fiduciaries to file these reports annually and then to reference the annual report when subsequent filings are made throughout the year.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the criminal background report and the credit history report filed by (professional fiduciary) in the above-referenced case shall be accepted by this Court as her annual reports pursuant to CRS §15-14-110(2)(a).

In connection with subsequent petitions for appointment in this Court until (date), when (professional fiduciary) files his/her Acceptance of Office, (s)he is authorized to request that the filing of a criminal background report and a credit history report be “waived;” provided, however, that she must also attach a copy of this Order. Granting a waiver is within the discretion of the Court and is not guaranteed. It is the responsibility of the nominee to advise the Court of any significant changes in information contained in the reports.

As part of the first Acceptance of Office filed by him/her after (date), (professional fiduciary) must file an updated criminal background report and a credit history report and may then also ask that this “rolling waiver” be renewed.
