
**ORDER SUPPRESSING PROTECTIVE PROCEEDINGS  
IN THE DENVER PROBATE COURT**

Pursuant to Art. VI, Sec. 9, para. (3) of the Constitution of the State of Colorado and Title 15, Article 14 of the Colorado Revised Statutes known as the Colorado Uniform Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Act, the people of the State of Colorado have vested in the Denver Probate Court both the authority and the responsibility to determine where and when protective proceedings are necessary to protect the health and welfare of vulnerable citizens of Colorado who do not have the capacity to protect themselves.

Any petition, motion or request for Court action in a Guardianship, Conservatorship or Personal Injury Settlement case, by its very nature, raises questions of competency and privacy. The Denver Probate Court has determined that it is in the best interest of protected persons that the files and records of all such protective proceedings should be suppressed from general public view. Chief Justice Directive 05-01 authorizes the Denver Probate Court to suppress case files under such circumstances.

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that all files of protected proceedings within the jurisdiction of the Denver Probate Court shall be and remain suppressed to all non-interested parties, as determined by the Clerk of Court, unless or until, upon written motion and notice, an Order of the Court opens such matter.
